January 7-27, 2024 21 Day Journal – Fasting & Prayer Time **Prepared by Pastor Lynda R. Espinoza**

Every year we take time to seek the Lord for 21 days. We purposely set aside this sacred time to Fast and Pray. We ask you to join us corporately as a church but also, please choose individually how you will fast and pray or join us in prayer only.

If you have health issues, please make sure you are cleared by a physician before you choose what type of fast you will be a participate in.

- 1. Absolute fast 3 days fasting and prayer no food and no water.
- 2. Partial Fast you choose to give up at least two meals and break your fast in the evening.
- 3. Water Fast no food; only water.
- 4. Daniel Fast 21 days of fruits, vegetables, legumes, nuts; oats; lots of water and 100% juice only no sugar, no caffeine, no bread, no meat at all. This is based on Daniel Chapter 1 & 10.

There are many recipes on-line these days to help you with food ideas or please feel free to ask the leadership for help.

Pray and decide how you will fast. If you have one bad day – get right back on the fast the next day. When you begin you must drink plenty of water, get plenty of rest and you may have a headache the first day or two. Do not do any heavy work as you will feel very weak. This is a religious sacrifice you are making before God. Seek Him and take time to hear from Him. Do not give up!

Once you choose your fast, please prepare to spend time in prayer as well. This will take you making time to spend with God. Change your daily routine – less TV or whatever robs you of your time with God. Along with prayer, please read the Word, journal, put your worship music on and be prepared for your spiritual awareness to be heightened in regard to how the Holy Spirit will minister to you and through you. It is amazing what takes place when you consecrate yourself to do this for 21 days.

What to Pray for?

Make sure you write out your personal prayer list and desires you would like to present to the Lord for 2024. Here are a few requests on behalf of CWC.

- Seek the Lord specifically for change and advancement in your walk with Him.
- Seek your giftings with the help of the Holy Spirit; be prepared to study them further in the Word; get ready for new understanding.

Why the Book of Joshua?

This year I chose our reading to be the book of Joshua. Joshua is a man who loved God and chose to have a personal relationship through spending time in prayer and being taught by Moses to trust and obey God at all times. He was an amazing leader as he and Israel stepped out in faith and faced so many unknowns. He was the one chosen by God, to lead the Israelites into the Promise Land after Moses' death.

There are seven major features in this book. (1) First OT historical book to describe Israel's history as a nation in the region of Palestine. (2) Great insight given as to Joshua being chosen by God to finish the work Moses started. To get God's people to the Promise Land and to be rightly established. (3) Many miracles took place in this book. One being the fall of Jericho (Ch. 6) and the prolonging of daylight hours during the battle at Gibeon (Ch. 10). (4) This book speaks of "Holy War" which were specific missions authorized by God to fulfill His overall plan of salvation throughout human history. (5) This book emphasizes three vital truths about God's relationship to his covenant people. (a) His faithfulness; (b) His holiness and (c) His salvation. (6) It is so important to pass on the testimony and heritage of God's saving acts from one generation to the next. And (7) We are taught to fear the Lord – An example was Achan's sin and punishment (Ch. 7); there were other challenges, warnings and penalties that came forth as well.

When I first became the Pastor of CWC back in 2007 we spent many amazing hours in prayer as a church. I recall God giving me this Word for my life, the life of CWC and I believe this Word is pertinent to your life as well. In 2024 as we step out in faith and face the unknowns, cling to God's promises for your future.

Joshua 1:6-9 NLT:

⁶ "Be strong and courageous, for you are the one who will lead these people to possess all the land I swore to their ancestors I would give them. ⁷ Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the instructions Moses gave you. Do not deviate from them, turning either to the right or to the left. Then you will be successful in everything you do. ⁸ Study this Book of Instruction continually. Meditate on it day and night so you will be sure to obey everything written in it. Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do. ⁹ This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."
